It was however, a very difficult trip as I was again struggling with my health. It almost seems the sad norm for me. My immune system is challenged but I want to believe there is healing for me. I saw a doctor three times and went on antibiotics as I had a lung infection and a sinus infection as well. I pushed myself to teach and really did feel the grace and strength of the Lord while I taught for many hours. We tried to send an earlier update but my computer just died and would not powerup or work at all. I thought I had lost my computer. This morning Tinie prayed for it -turned it on and thank you Lord it worked.

Thank you all so much for all your prayers. I have another invitation to Spain in the Fall.

We came home for two days before flying out again.

For my 70th Birthday, my children had arranged to take me on a week mini-vacation to Punta Cana, Dominican Republic. This is the first time we have all been on vacation together with Evan, Nathan, Jared and Amie, Tarah and Richard and Weston - Tinie too. It has been so relaxing and refreshing but I'm sad to say, I'm still struggling with my health. I spent the best part of my Birthday in a hospital. Still that did not dampen our spirits. It was just wonderful - Beach, Palm Trees and lots of good food.

On June 19th, Evan graduates from College and he has made the Dean's Honour List for the last two semesters - straight 'A's. We are so proud. of him.
